 to under the act of February 15, 1934 (48 Stat. 261; U. S. C. 5: 796), and that I shall not be entitled to any allowances upon release  
 except transportation in kind to the place at which I was accepted for enrollment. I understand further that any articles  
 furnished me by the United States Government for use while a member of the Civilian Conservation Corps are, and remain, property  
 of the United States Government and that without destruction, loss, sale, or disposal of such property renders me financially respon-  
 sible for the same and liable to trial in the civil courts. I understand further that any infraction of the rules or regulations of
