

THE WEATHER

United States Department of Agriculture, Weather Bureau, New Orleans, La., Dec. 3.—The forecast is Louisiana: Monday, rain, colder in northwest portion; Tuesday probably fair, colder; moderate to fresh southerly winds on the coast becoming northwest Monday night.

Mississippi: Showers Monday, Tuesday clearing and colder, much colder Tuesday night; fresh southerly winds, shifting to northwest by Tuesday.

Florida: Fair Monday; Tuesday cloudy, probably showers; not much change in temperature; moderate southerly winds increasing by Tuesday.

Extreme Northwest Florida, Alabama: Showers Monday and probably Tuesday, colder Tuesday or Tuesday night; much colder by Wednesday morning; fresh southerly winds, shifting to northwest Tuesday.

Tennessee: Rain Monday and probably Tuesday, colder Tuesday, much colder Tuesday night.

Arkansas: Monday, rain, probably turning to snow in north portion, cold wave, temperature 18 to 26 degrees in north and 24 to 30 degrees in south portion Tuesday morning; Tuesday, probably fair, continued cold.

Oklahoma: Monday, partly cloudy, cold wave; Tuesday, generally fair, rising temperature in northwest portion. Fresh to strong northerly winds Monday.
