Translation of Will of "Girolamo Corrao"
 I, the undersigned "Girolamo Corrao," son of "Liberio Corrao"
 and "Giuseppa Pennacchio" both deceased, native of
 Mezzojuso, Province of Palermo, in the presence of the
 undersigned witnesses, and in possession of all my fac-
 ulties mental, and of my own proper and spontaneous
 wish, declare as follows.

To possess a farm in Contrada Rivieri,
 territory of Mezzojuso, and another one in Contrada Santo
 Rocco, territory of Mezzojuso, this last one confining
 on one side with that of "Girolamo D'Urigo" and on
 the other side with that of Tommaso Pennacchio, also a
 house with grounds appertaining, situated in Mezzojuso,
 Contrada Macello.

The whole as hereinabove expressed, I declare
 to leave, in case of my death, to my lawful & legitimate
 wife, "Francesca D'usa, whom I institute my sole and
 lawful heir.

Also I declare to hold in my possession, bearing
 the date of month of October 1896 a receipt of M^{rs} Joseph
 Vaccaro of New Orleans for the sum of three hundred
 dollars, which sum has been loaned to him with the
 promise on his part to reimburse it on my request.

Also to have loaned to M^{rs} Nicolo Di
 Giovanni the sum of seventy five dollars, for which sum
 so loaned I have no receipt.

In reference to the three hundred dollars
 loaned to Jos Vaccaro as also in reference to the seventy
 five dollars loaned to Nicolo Di Giovanni I charge my
