FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF NEW-ORLEANS.

NEW-ORLEANS, 26th August 1847

PERSONALLY came and appeared before me, John McHenry Judge of the
FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF NEW-ORLEANS, Peter Buhler a native of
Wurtemberg — aged fifty — years, who being duly sworn, says that he arrived
in the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, TO WIT: at the city of New Orleans in the State of Louisiana
on the twenty fourth day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
and since the year one thousand eight hundred and forty — has resided within the limits of the STATE OF LOUISIANA,
and that his BONA FIDE intention is to become a CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as soon as by the laws thereof he can be
naturalised as such.

And the said Peter Buhler further swear that he does and will forever renounce all
allegiance and fidelity to any Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and more particularly to William
Duke of Sualia, King of Wurtemberg of whom he is a subject.
