M. Crozat**, duly commissioned and sworn RECORDER OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS, in and for the Parish and City of Orleans, personally appeared,

M^r Anton Buhler, a Shoemaker residing in Ursulines Street between M^{rs} of Toussie Street, in the first Municipality of this City, who by their presents declares that on the thirty first day of May of this present year, (May 31st 1849) at half past ten o'clock A. M. at his aforesaid residence was born a female child named Magdalena Buhler issue of the legitimate marriage of the deponent with the late M^{rs} Magdalena Meyer a native of Prussia
