BE IT REMEMBERED That on this day, to-wit: the *third of October* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *forty nine* and the seventy *fourth* of the Independence of the United States of America, before us, **F. M. Crozat**, duly commissioned and sworn RECORDER OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS, in and for the Parish and City of Orleans, personally appeared,

M^r Anton Buhler, residing in Iberville Street between Noye and Conti Streets, in the first Municipality of this City who by then presents declares, that Magdalena Buhler, born in this City on the 3^d day of May last, the legitimate daughter of deponent and of M^{rs} Magdalena Lick; Died on the sixteenth day of September of this present year (September 16th 1849) at the aforesaid residence of deponent.
